Youth Orchestras of San Antonio Seeks Conductor, YOSA Symphony

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Conductor of the YOSA Symphony is responsible for Youth Orchestras of San Antonio's second most advanced orchestra. He or she will serve as the YOSA Symphony's primary conductor, leading weekly rehearsals on Sunday afternoons throughout the school year, a weekend retreat in August, and at least three major concerts each year. In consultation with the YOSA Music Director, he or she will select repertoire and guest artists, plan details of rehearsals and sectionals, and manage placement and seating of student musicians. As a member of the YOSA conducting faculty, he or she will participate in judging annual auditions each June, collaborate on the development of artistic plans, and maintain relationships with musicians and teachers in the community. He or she will also be expected to be in regular contact with administrative staff and may be asked to be available for additional meetings or events from time to time.

QUALIFICATIONS:

The ideal candidate will have exceptional musicianship and conducting skills; a proven track record of success in inspiring and motivating high school age orchestral musicians; strong skills in interpersonal relationships, leadership, and communication; and a strong ability to work and communicate with young people, music teachers, and school administrators. Residency in San Antonio will be required.

COMPENSTION:

Between \$8,000 and \$10,000 annually, with the position beginning in August 2010.
