

Be prepared to perform all components of your chosen audition:


1. One major or minor scale with arpeggio that best demonstrates your ability level.

2. The bracketed section of <u>any two</u> of the excerpts below. Please choose excerpts that you can prepare thoroughly and play well; playing excerpts that are too difficult will usually lower your score. (Less advanced players can choose to play only the first excerpt.)

3. A brief solo of your choice that best demonstrates your playing ability. Solos should be a 2-3 minute selection performed without accompaniment.

4. Sight reading that will be presented by the judges at the audition.

Excerpt #1: **Peters, Melody, complete** Quarter Note = 100 Time Signature = 4/4





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Excerpt #2:

Bernstein (arr. Peress), West Side Story Overture, Clarinet I, mm. 27-53

Quarter Note = 132 Time Signature = 4/4









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
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Excerpt #3:

Copland, Appalachian Spring Suite, Clarinet I, mm. 486-505

Quarter Note = 72

Time Signature = 2/4





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3. A brief solo of your choice that best demonstrates your playing ability. Solos should be a 2-3 minute selection performed without accompaniment.

4. Sight reading that will be presented by the judges at the audition.

Excerpt #4:

Tchaikovsky, Romeo and Juliet Fantasy Overture, Clarinet I, as marked

NOTE Clarinet in A (may be played on B-flat clarinet un-transposed, if necessary) Quarter Note = 126, Time Signature = 4/4
