



JOB TITLE: Operations Assistant
ORGANIZATION: YOSA (Youth Orchestras of San Antonio)

JOB SUMMARY: The Operations Assistant is responsible for general administrative support to the Operations Director and operations staff, ensuring effective production of all youth orchestra events (concerts, rehearsals, special events), including but not limited to maintaining student database, communication to students and families, music distribution, responding to membership inquiries, and assisting with recruitment.

JOB DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Rehearsal & Concert Production

- Assist with day-to-day operations related to weekly rehearsals.
- Assist in all YOSA Summer Symphony Camp production activities.
- Ensure best possible physical working conditions for the orchestra(s) in all situations.
- Ensure proper and timely setup/breakdown of percussion instruments, chairs, stands, and music.
- Direct volunteers in setup and breakdown on a weekly basis.
- Provide support to ensemble directors, coaches, and section leaders.
- Create and manage music copies, including extra parts.
- Manage Intern(s) in operation of rehearsals and concerts.

Administrative

- Maintain all student and family data related to YOSA Orchestra and Summer Symphony Camp participation to ensure accuracy.
- Process weekly attendance and enforce any policy violations. Prepare monthly attendance report and submit to Operations Director.
- Generate weekly mass email to students and parents; additional mass email generation as needed.
- Provide updated rosters to Office Coordinator for program books.
- Assist in training and management of Intern(s) and Volunteers.
- Assist in maintaining inventories of property and assets (instruments, equipment) making periodic checks for reports to the Operations Director.
- Assess member policy effectiveness and report findings to Operations Director.
- Provide general administrative support to operations staff.
- Become fluent in technologies used by YOSA operations staff, including but not limited to: Constant Contact, SetMore, FormAssembly, PaySimple, Salesforce, Bandcamp, WordPress, and PayPal.

Other

- Assist in coordinating activities of Development, Marketing and Public Relations departments for special projects involving use of venues, stage crew, and/or orchestra musicians.
- Other duties as assigned by Operations Director

REQUIREMENTS: The successful candidate shall have a bachelor's degree or equivalent in music education, performance, arts management, or a related field. This position requires the following qualities: integrity, a commitment to an extremely high level of customer service, confidentiality, self-starter mentality, the ability to multi-task and prioritize effectively, excellent written, verbal, and

interpersonal skills, fanatical attention to detail, and the ability to interact effectively with diverse constituencies. Some overtime will be expected - evenings / weekends and team lifting of heavy objects. In-depth knowledge of symphonic music and music education as well as proficiency in Microsoft Office is essential.

ORGANIZATION DESCRIPTION:

YOSA (Youth Orchestras of San Antonio), the premier orchestral experience for youth citywide, enhances education, enriches the community, and transforms lives by pursuing excellence in classical music in a stimulating, nurturing, and fun environment that is equally accessible to all youth. What began as a community orchestra in 1949 has grown to become one of the top youth orchestra programs in the country. YOSA serves more than 3,000 youth annually who represent 155 schools and 25 school districts across the region. During the past five years, YOSA has awarded more than \$350,000 in community supported scholarships to those needing assistance to participate in high quality music programs. New and innovative programming has drawn praise from groups that include the National Endowment for the Arts, ASCAP, Musical America Worldwide, and Centro San Antonio. YOSA represents San Antonio internationally with concert tours every two years, including a 2018 tour to Spain in celebration of San Antonio's Tricentennial. YOSA is a resident company of the Tobin Center for the Performing Arts.

ORCHESTRAS

YOSA supports nine orchestras that rehearse weekly throughout the school year. The YOSA Philharmonic, the most advanced YOSA orchestra, performs professional-level repertoire in premier venues at home and abroad, collaborating regularly with internationally renowned soloists and composers.

CAMP

YOSA offers three one-week Summer Symphony Camp sessions that gives students an opportunity to continue their musical studies with special focus areas of composition, string orchestra, advanced orchestra and band, chamber music, and alternative music.

SCHOOL PARTNERSHIPS

YOSA MÀS:Music at School, is an intensive program offering supplementary services in support of transforming school orchestra programs into world-class music education centers. YOSA provides private lessons, sectional coaches, clinicians, teaching assistants, concert tickets, and other resources, as well as tuition assistance for affiliated students to participate in YOSA programs.

Started in 2017, the YOSA Invitational is a community resource that invites local middle and high school bands and orchestras to rehearse, perform, and record in San Antonio's premier venue, the Tobin Center for the Performing Arts, at no cost to the school. In May 2018, 20 local school programs will participate in the second annual YOSA Invitational.
